Need for mailing issue to be addressed as some folks don't have email. Decided to do both mailers and email going forward. Neil thanked Tim for the video he graciously filmed. Tim would like to get it on FB and will reach out our FB gal Ginny to see the process. Thanks to Ginny for putting the photos of the winners from the show on FB. Discussion of cutting out one day and doing just Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Eliminate Thursday. Do we do Thursday evening? For further discussion for next year's shows.

Tim spoke about the "Open Mic" idea and possibilities. The Blake Room at the library would be available but limited time frame. Having it at Piedmont 7-9 on the 4th Saturday of each month beginning in October. Dates discussed: Oct.26, Nov 23, skip Dec, Jan 25 and Feb 22. Tim said he would reach out to Bob Hall who is involved with the high school for possible student interest and contact. Advertising is important for this event. People could bring their own snacks or have something simple there. More discussion in moving forward; members excited with the idea.

Also, a problem with parking as large crowd and holiday. Could hold it at the high school. They already have the chairs, parking and the cost of the janitor. Rain or shine, discussion leaned toward the high school. Dave motioned to hold it at the high school with costs for 4 hours. Dan seconded. Approved. The Windham Band with 70-90 members at the high school on the 4th!!

New Business: Commission running into storage problems for all our signs for the concerts. Terri searched for a container(storage unit). Ann checked with Donna at the senior center for room on the side of outside building for small unit. Approved by center. Dave motioned to purchase such a unit for \$200 or less and Eileen seconded. Approved by members. Ceiling at Piedmont has many water-stained ceiling tiles in need of repair. Todd Roland is aware per conversation with Terri.
